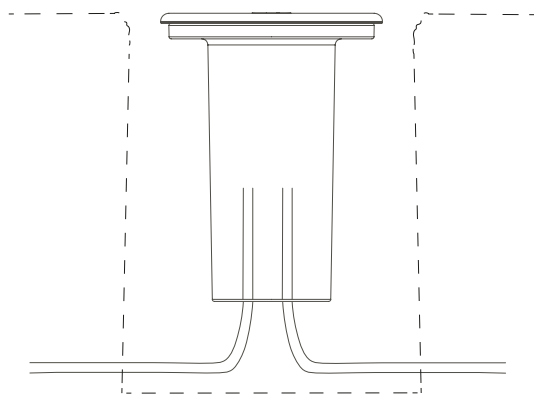
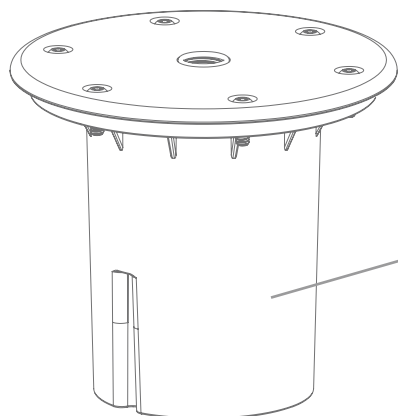
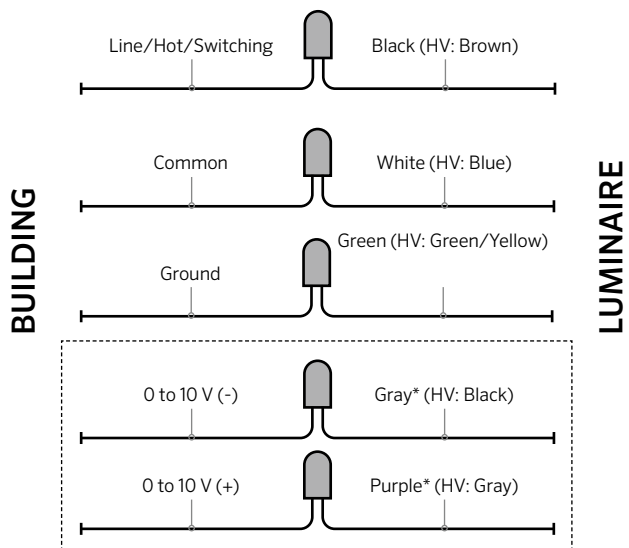


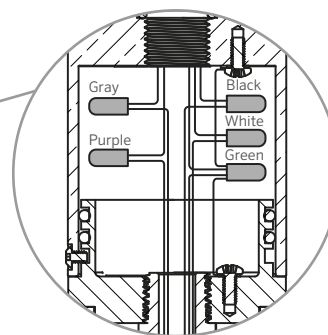

*For use with 0 to 10 V driver only

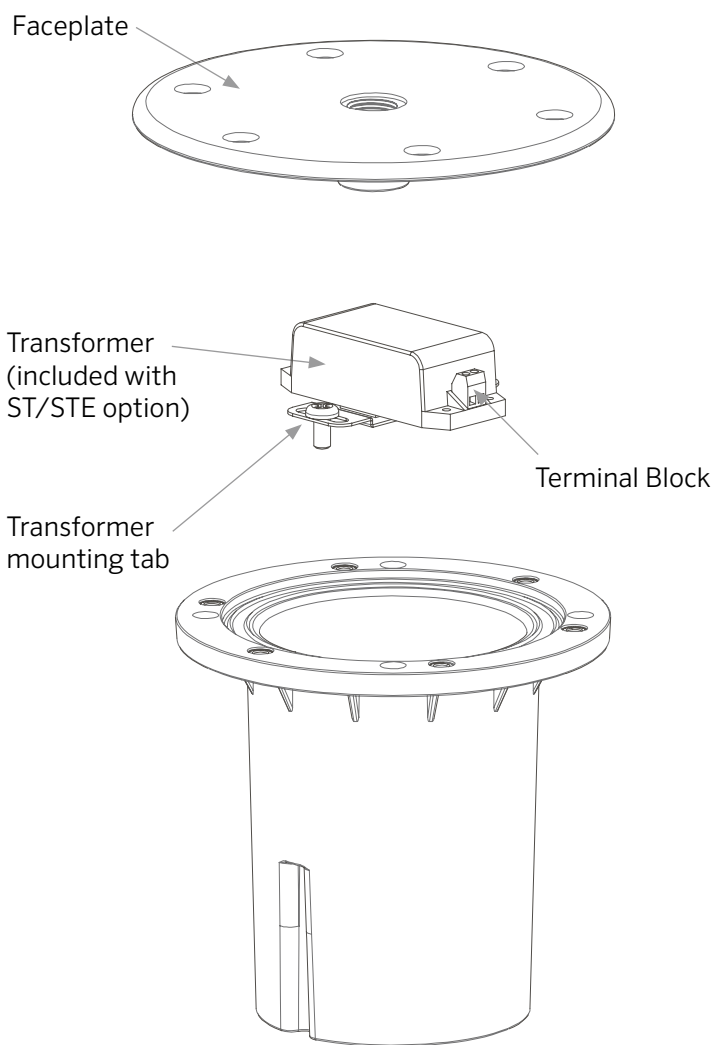

1. Secure the driver housing in-ground in accordance with local codes and regulations (Figure 1).
2. Connect conduit or cable runs to the bottom of the driver housing with couplings ($\frac{1}{2}$ "-14 NPT; not included). Use the provided $\frac{1}{2}$ "-14 NPT plug for unused conduit openings.
3. Add the installation cover onto the driver housing with the provided fasteners to prevent dirt and debris from entering the driver housing (Figure 2).
4. To complete the installation, use double-sided tape to secure the transformer to the transformer mounting tab (Figure 3).
5. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{3}{8}$ " screws to secure the transformer mount to the inside bottom of the housing with a #3 Phillips screwdriver (Figure 3).
6. Connect the luminaire/conduit/cable (not included) to the $\frac{1}{2}$ "-14 NPT opening of the faceplate. Install the included O-ring gasket (Figure 3).
7. Use the wiring diagram and approved wire connectors to connect the transformer wiring.
8. Tighten the 8-32 x $\frac{1}{2}$ " setscrew using a $\frac{5}{64}$ " Allen wrench to lock the rotational position of the luminaire to the driver housing faceplate.
9. Seal the driver housing compartment using the provided gasket and fasteners ($\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{3}{4}$ " screws) with a $\frac{5}{32}$ " Allen wrench.
